

**THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLOUCESTER  
TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 – SECTION 21  
GLOUCESTER ARMED FORCES DAY PARADE ORDER 2024**

The Council of the City of Gloucester (being a District Council for the purposes of Section 2 of the Local Government Act 1972) ("the Council") is exercising its powers pursuant to Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.

**WHEREAS** the Council is satisfied that the following streets will be thronged or liable to be restricted and traffic should be restricted as hereinafter provided to enable the Gloucester Armed Forces Day Parade procession to take place.


**NOW THEREFORE** the Council pursuant to its said powers **HEREBY ORDER** that between 12:30PM and 12:50PM on Saturday the 29<sup>th</sup> day of June 2024 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle (other than police, fire or ambulance vehicles being used for the provision of an emergency service) to be driven or to proceed in the following lengths of roads in the City of Gloucester:

- College Street from Gloucester Cathedral for its entire length
- Westgate Street from its junction with College Street to the crossroads with Northgate Street, Eastgate Street and Southgate Street
- Southgate Street from the crossroads with Northgate Street, Eastgate Street and Westgate Street to its junction with Commercial Road
- Southgate Street from its junction with Commercial Road to the first junction on the left after the Southgate Moorings – Gloucester Docks Car Park

This Order may be cited as The Council of the City of Gloucester Armed Forces Day Parade Order 2024.

The penalty for infringement of the aforesaid Order is a fine not exceeding One Thousand Pounds (£1,000).
